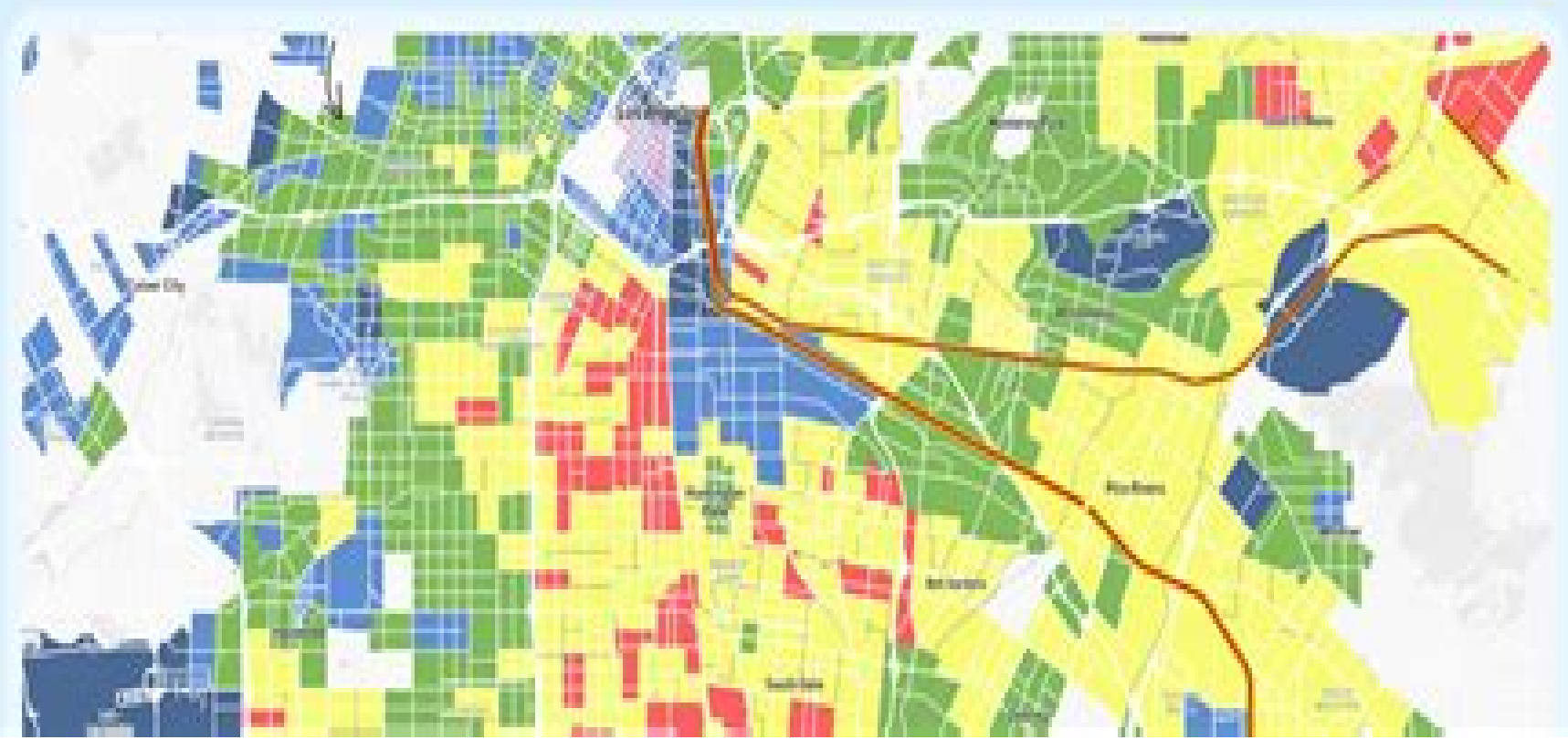

detriment of developing the country The built environment impacts were equally concerning resulting in dysfunctional cityscapes that were over saturated with contentious monuments and poorly constructed buildings The research findings thus underscore the highly politicized processes of constructing capitals in hybrid regimes offering insight into how civil society and international donors might work to hold incumbent parties accountable *Urban Politics* Stephen J.
