

POINTS TO INCLUDE IN YOUR PERSUASIVE ESSAY

Introduction:

1. Hook: Capture the reader's attention with a compelling opening.
2. Background information: Provide context on the topic.
3. Thesis statement: Clearly state your position or argument.

Body paragraphs:

1. Present your main arguments, supported by evidence and examples.
2. Address counterarguments and refute them logically.
3. Use persuasive techniques such as ethos, pathos, and logos to appeal to the audience.
4. Organize paragraphs effectively, with each one focusing on a single point.

Conclusion:

1. Restate the thesis and summarize key points.
2. Reinforce the importance of your argument and its implications.
3. Call to action: Encourage readers to take a specific course of action or consider your viewpoint.
