By helping to condition the German population to geopolitical ideas which emphasized revision of the Versailles settlement and enlarging Germany's living space geopolitics helped contribute to Nazi imperialism. Theories of geographical determinism shaped German thinking about politics, race, science, education, aesthetics, and many other subjects on the eve of the Nazi era.
