- ATP is adenosine triphosphate (ADP).
- A molecule that transfers energy down the potential energy hill from molecules to cells processes.

- Photosynthesis, which some organisms use chemical energy released by light energy to store energy in carbon-based molecules.
- ATP has three phosphate groups; ADP has two phosphate groups.
- Together, they mean "put together with chemical aid." In chlorophyll, chemical energy is used to produce carbon-based molecules that store energy.

Carbon dioxide and water (the reactants) enter chlorophyll. Through many chemical reactions, with the help of many enzymes, a six-carbon sugar and oxygen (the products) are formed.
- The light-dependent reactions require light, and they store and transfer energy. The light-independent reactions do not directly need light, and they break sugars. **Light** for **Chlorophyll** (Step 1) Energy from sunlight is absorbed and transferred along the light-based molecules. Water molecules are broken down and oxygen is released. (2) Energy stored along the light-based molecules is transferred to molecules that carry energy to the light-independent reactions. (3) Carbon dioxide is added to a cycle of chemical reactions, to break sugar molecules. (4) A six-carbon simple sugar (usually glucose; $\text{C}_6\text{H}_{12}\text{O}_6$) is formed.
- Energy from light is used to put sugars together.
- Chlorophyll is the light-absorbing molecule that makes leaves look green.
- The light-dependent reactions require sunlight, the light-independent reactions don't need sunlight.
