National Transportation Safety Board, 2007 On December 8 2005 about 1914 central standard time Southwest Airlines SWA flight 1248 a Boeing 737 7H4 N471WN ran off the departure end of runway 31C after landing at Chicago Midway International Airport Chicago Illinois The airplane rolled through a blast fence an airport perimeter fence and onto an adjacent roadway where it struck an automobile before coming to a stop A child in the automobile was killed one automobile occupant received serious injuries and three other automobile occupants received minor injuries Eighteen of the 103 airplane occupants 98 passengers 3 flight attendants and 2 pilots received minor injuries and the airplane was substantially damaged The airplane was being operated under the provisions of 14 Code of Federal Regulations Part 121 and had departed from Baltimore Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport Baltimore Maryland about 1758 eastern standard time Instrument meteorological conditions prevailed at the time of the accident flight which operated on an instrument flight rules flight plan The National Transportation Safety Board determined that the probable cause of this accident was the pilots failure to use available reverse thrust in a timely manner to safely slow or stop the airplane after landing which resulted in a runway overrun This failure occurred because the pilots first experience and lack of familiarity with the airplane autobrake system distracted them from thrust reverser usage during the challenging landing strip The safety issues discussed in this report include the flight crews decisions and actions the clarity of assumptions used in on
