The military establishment has locked the country in an enduring rivalry with India with the primary aim of wresting Kashmir from it. To that end Pakistan initiated three wars over Kashmir in 1947 1965 and 1999 and failed to win any of them. Today the army continues to prosecute this dangerous policy by employing non state actors under the security of its ever expanding nuclear umbrella. It has sustained a proxy war in Kashmir since 1989 using Islamist militants as well as supporting non Islamist insurgencies throughout India and a country wide Islamist terror campaign that have brought the two countries to the brink of war on several occasions. In addition to these territorial revisionist goals the Pakistani army has committed itself to resisting India's slow but inevitable rise on the global stage. Figure 2 Bombing Waziristan by Westland Wapitis in 1933. The post 1947 rulers of Pakistan instead of remedying a basically illogical recruitment policy which had no logical basis became its victim. Thus whenever army was used in a province other than Punjab it was perceived as Punjab against Sindh or Punjab against Bengal or Punjab against Baluchistan. The rulers were merely the instruments of a pre 1947 policy. The army outside Punjab was trigger happy because it was fighting in a foreign land. For short term purposes this policy is viable but for how long. In the long term it will only lead to creation of more Bangladeshis. The British divided us by their negative policies both in India and in Pakistan. In Pakistan the problem became more serious because the military usurpers were not interested in changing.
