



DEFINITIONS:

- **Transvenous & epicardial** pacing are temporary methods of supporting brady- & tachyarrhythmias until resolution or definitive treatment (such as a permanent implanted pacemaker) can be implanted.
- External cardiac pacing involves connecting one or more pacing electrodes (called leads) to an external pulse generator (also called an external pacer box).
- Transvenous and epicardial pacing are more reliable and more durable treatments than transcutaneous pacing. (Both are pictured, though would not be used simultaneously.)

USES:

- Pacing can be used to support patients with severe **BRADYCARDIA** or **HEART BLOCK** leading to hemodynamic compromise. HR or bradycardia may be due to surgery, MI, electrolyte disturbances, toxicities.
- **OVERDRIVE PACING** is a technique for **suppressing arrhythmias** (such ventricular tachycardia or Torsades de pointes) by selecting a rate faster than the arrhythmia to **overdrive suppress** it, then decreasing the rate once the arrhythmia is suppressed.

INITIATING PACING:

Set the **MODE** to asynchronous (either VVI or DDD)



Set the desired **RATE** (should be more than the native HR to initiate pacing; typically 80 bpm).



Set the **OUTPUT** to the maximum energy & confirm mechanical **CAPTURE** (feel a pulse, look pulse/Ox/Aline waveform)



Determine **THRESHOLD** by decreasing **OUTPUT** until capture is lost; set the **OUTPUT** to twice the **THRESHOLD**



Change to a sensing **MODE** (either VVI or DDD)




Adjust **SENSITIVITY** until the native complexes are detected



Temporarily decrease **RATE** to be less than the native HR
