Twenty inhabitants lost their lives at that time; nineteen were hanged on Gallows Hill and one elderly man, Giles Cory, by remaining mute as a personal protest to the proceedings of the court was pressed to death under heavy weights. Once the prosecuting examinations began on March 1, 1692, local authorities were uncertain what course the following trials would take. Spectral evidence in which the shape of a suspected witch tortured people was a primary indication of guilt as was the touch test in which a victim was released from the witch's power upon the laying on of hands. Not being able to correctly recite the Lord's Prayer was also damning.
