When war came to Britain in September 1939 RAF Bomber Command was incapable of conducting sustained strategic air warfare against Germany The new plans for rearmament each more ambitious than its predecessor had not produced aircraft capable of penetrating into the German heartland from British bases The 4 engine bombers needed for the air operations envisioned by Trenchard Chief of Air Staff from 1918 to 1930 he has been described as the Father of the Royal Air Force and one of the early advocates of strategic bombing were either in the prototype stage or still on the drawing boards The inventory of Bomber Command consisted of single engine Fairey Battles and twinengine Bristol Blenheims neither of which could be regarded as a strategic bomber Armstrong Whitworth Whitleys Handley Page Hampdens and Vickers Wellingtons were also available although not in large quantities but their short range limited them to targets in the Ruhr or Wilhelmshaven Not only were there materiel limitations there was also a chronic dearth of trained personnel especially in the observer fields Next to the skill necessary to fly an aircraft the ability to navigate to the required position in space and then to drop bombs on a precise target was a prerequisite to success At first it was believed that the pilot of even the heaviest bomber should be able to navigate to and from a target No one seemed to realize that long range navigation particularly at night required special skill and training By 1937 a half hearted gesture toward recognizing this was made when a second pilot trained in navigation was assigned to all medium and heavy bombers But in some machines such as the Hampdens there was no room for another pilot The solution to this dilemma was to substitute a man trained in navigation bombing and gunnery for the gunner It was not until the eve of the war that navigation was recognized as a field in which a fully trained specialist was needed Because it had taken so long for the RAF to recognize this need the early training was mediocre Instruments that navigators take for granted today computers driftmeters celestial compasses declination tables and sextants were rudimentary and unreliable As late as May 1939 one Bomber Command Group Commander reported that dead reckoning navigation by day above a cloud layer could not be expected to bring an aircraft any closer than 50 miles of its target 1 Compounding these problems was the small number of bomber crews available for tactical operations Most of the crewmen were being used as training cadres for the expansion of the force A high rate of casualties in the opening months of the war would not only endanger the force in being but might well compromise the future of offensive air operations Because of its materiel status in 1939 Bomber Command could only hope to be an investment for the future This meant that the strategic air arm must avoid a pitched battle with the Luftwaffe
