

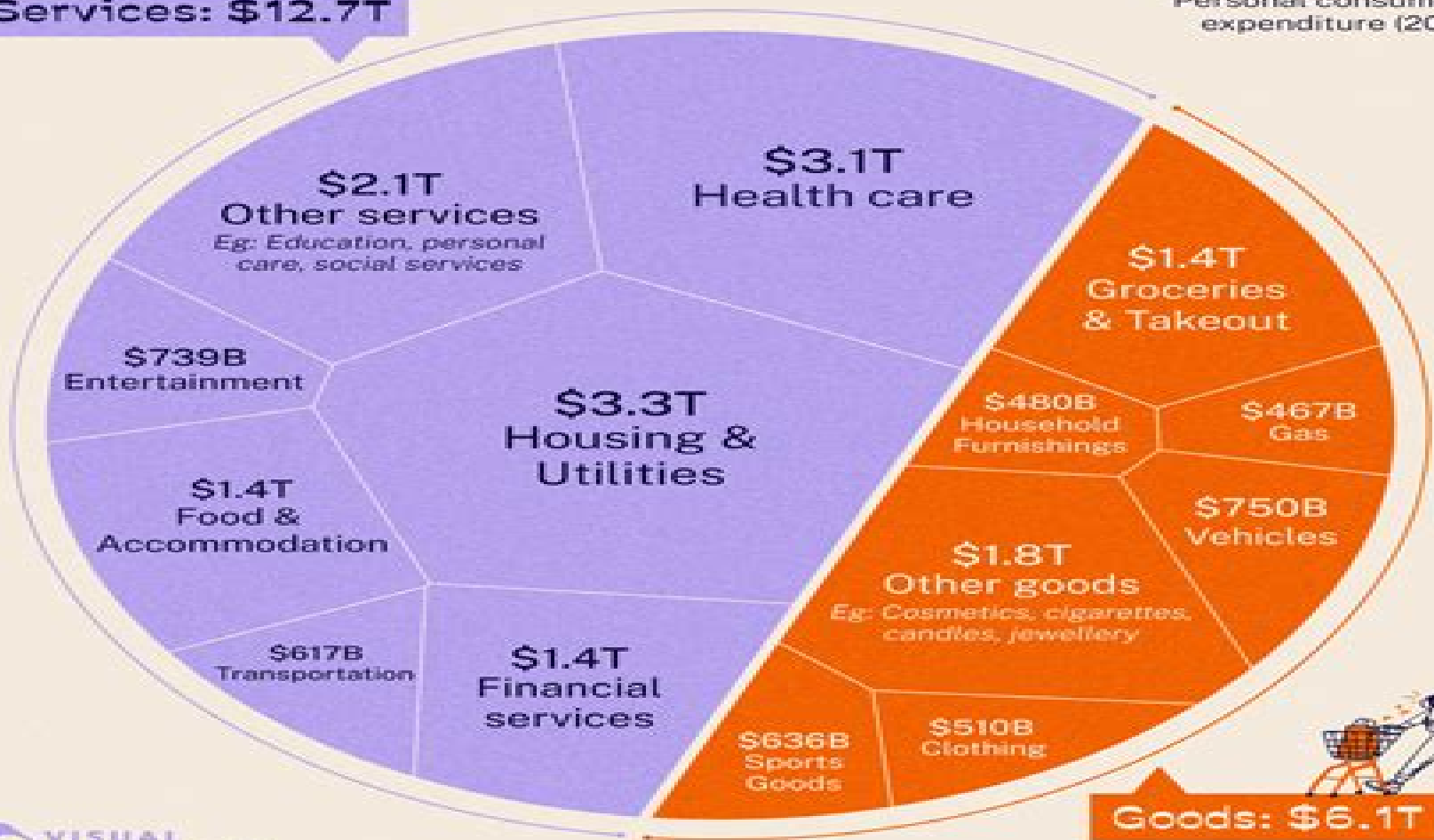

Cross, 2000 The unqualified victory of consumerism in America was not a foregone conclusion The United States has traditionally been the home of the most aggressive and often thoughtful criticism of consumption including Puritanism Prohibition the simplicity movement the 60s hippies and the consumer rights
