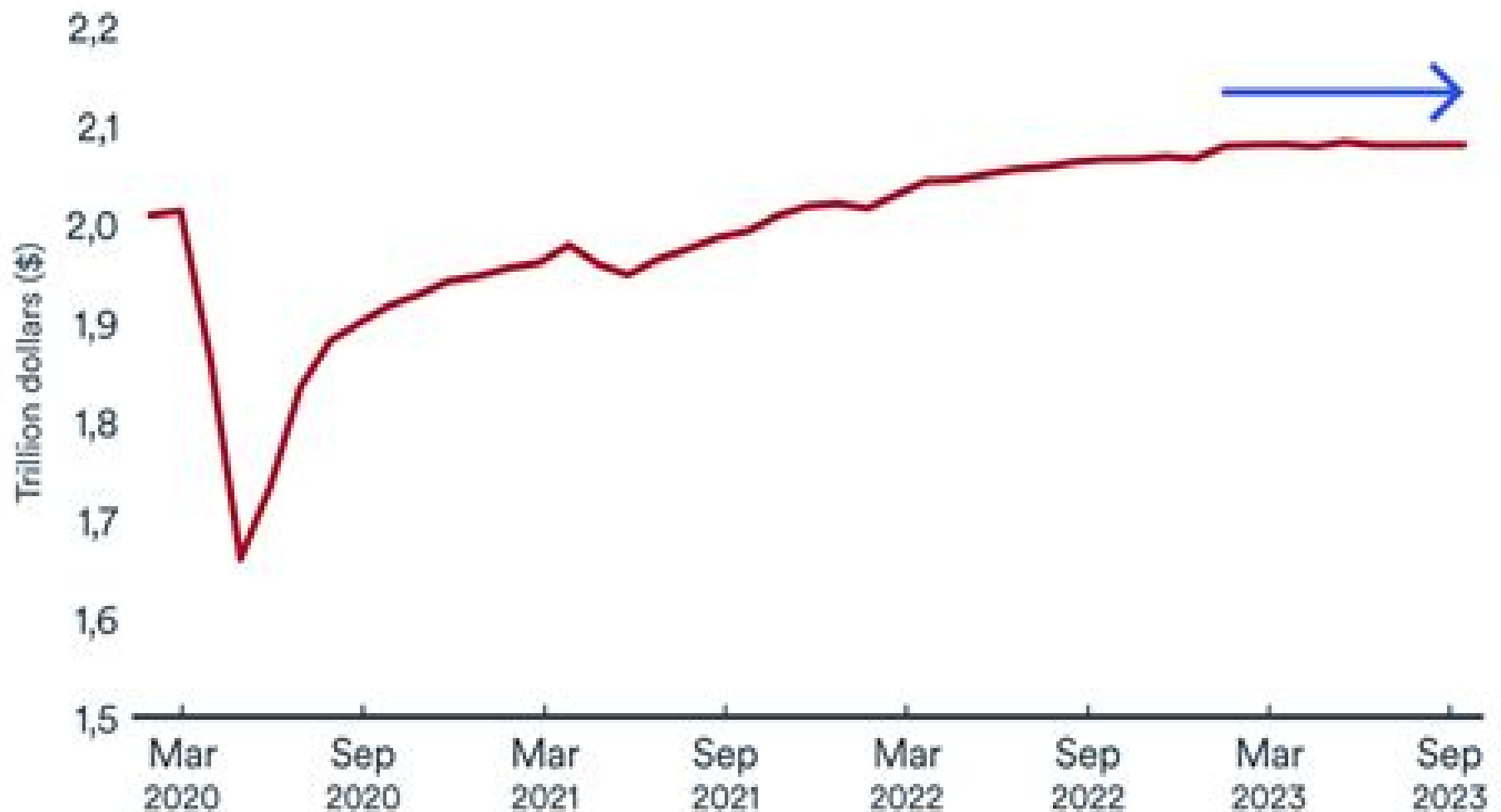

Finally, it addresses the issue of the existence or not of electoral and partisan cycles in Canada by incorporating both fiscal and monetary principles and applying them to the lively world of Canadian politics.

Johnson is best known as one of Canada's most respected economists, particularly for his research on international trade and finance and monetary policy. But Johnson was also a prolific and influential public intellectual. Although Trudeau's Foreign Investment Review Agency and National Energy Policy have been dismantled, economic nationalism persists; it is a testament to both the lucidity of Johnson's mind and the vigour and clarity of his writing that many of his opinions on this debate remain fresh, interesting, and relevant.
